UPON CONSIDERATION of Plaintiffs' Motion to Approve Class I and Class II Certification Settlement Notice, having considered all the reasons stated in said Motion, Defendants' consent thereto, and any opposition thereto, it is hereby,

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' Motion is GRANTED; and it is further,

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' counsel shall create and maintain a website as outlined in the Notice(s) where class members may obtain a complete copy of the Legal Notice short form attached as Exhibit ~~B~~ or the long form attached as Exhibit ~~A~~ and obtain

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copies of the Plaintiffs' Complaint and the Defendants' responsive pleadings, this Order and the Exclusion Request / Opt Out Form; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' counsel shall publish the Short Form Notice, Exhibit B, as approved in a newspaper of general circulation in Howard, Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Charles, Frederick, Harford, Prince George's and Wicomico counties once a week for three consecutive weeks beginning on or about July 10, 2008; and it is further


ORDERED, that class members shall have until September 15, 2008 to opt out of the class or file an objection to the settlement; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' counsel shall file with the court a compilation of names and addresses of any person who has opted out, and class counsel shall serve a notice to all class members by regular mail that decide to opt out of the class; and it is further

ORDERED, that a Fairness Hearing to determine Final Approval and Findings of Fact on October 2, 2008 at 9:30 a.m..
