ORDER APPROVING CLASS CERTIFICATION NOTICE

UPON CONSIDERATION of Plaintiffs' Motion to Approve Class Certification Notice, having considered all the reasons stated in said Motion, Defendants' consent thereto, and any opposition thereto, it is hereby,

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' Motion is GRANTED; and it is further,

ORDERED, that Defendant Eastern Homes, Inc. shall make available to Plaintiffs' counsel all sales and installation records for completing a mailing list of all class members within 10 days of the entry of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' counsel shall provide individual notice to all members of the class by mailing Legal Notice in the short form, attached as Exhibit A to this Order, on or before December 15, 2006 to the addresses as compiled from the Eastern Homes, Inc. sales and installation records since August 25, 2000 through the present date; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' counsel shall create and maintain a website as outlined in the Notice(s) where class members may obtain a complete copy of the Legal Notice attached as Exhibit B or the long form and obtain copies of the Plaintiffs'

Complaint and the Defendants' responsive pleadings, this Order and the Exclusion Request / Opt Out Form; and it is further


ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' counsel shall publish the Legal Notice, Exhibit A, as approved in a newspaper of general circulation in Howard, Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Charles, Frederick, Harford, Prince George's and Wicomico counties once a week for three consecutive weeks; and it is further

ORDERED, that class members shall have until March 1, 2007 to opt out of the class; and it is further

ORDERED, that Plaintiffs' counsel shall file with the court a compilation of names and addresses of any person who has opted out, and class counsel shall serve a notice to all class members by regular mail that decide to opt out of the class; and it is further

ORDERED, that a trial on the merits shall commence on June 25, 2007.
